### **SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE**

Preparation is by appointment with our Parish Priests at least six months in advance.

**This Tuesday we will celebrate the feast of All Saints. It is a holy day of obligation with Masses at 8:30am and 7:00pm.** We celebrate those members of the Church who already beheld the glory of God in heaven. It is an important opportunity to remind ourselves that our destiny is to attain happiness, peace and perfection in the presence of God. Nowadays we are so focused on achieving worldly success and contentment that this reminder of our true end is critical to our outlook on life, and the approach we take toward our endeavors and struggles.

**Wednesday is All Souls Day, with Mass at 8:30am and 5:30pm.** It is a day dedicated to remembering the faithful departed and praying for them. The saints are those who died free from all guilt and punishment due to sin, or those who have been purified of all their ties to sin and now enjoy the company of God and the saints. The souls in purgatory are those who need time to be cleansed from their attachment to sin and to make satisfaction for the sins committed while on earth. (1 Corinthians 3:15, 2 Maccabees 12:44-46, 1Peter 3:18-20; 4:6, 2 Timothy 1:6-9)

One of the spiritual works of mercy is to pray for the living and the dead. We, whether on earth or in heaven, are members of the same Church. That is why we can turn to the saints for their assistance. The Church is the treasury of grace that Christ, the Blessed Virgin and the saints have won. The Church allows us to draw on that grace to win the lessening of that time of purification for the souls in purgatory. We do that by fulfilling the requirements that the Church sets down. **A plenary indulgence** is granted for the souls in purgatory by doing either of the following:

- On any day from November 1-8, devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only mentally, for the departed.
- On All Soul's Day, devoutly visit a church and recite an Our Father and the Creed.

The conditions for any plenary indulgence, which must be fulfilled several days before or after the act, are:

- Sacramental confession
- Reception of Holy Communion
- Prayer for the intentions of the Pope.
