During my recent visit to Ireland I was listening to a radio report about students who are applying for college courses. The journalist stated that many European universities are struggling to stay open due to the very low birth rate throughout the continent. As a result they are offering incentives to foreign students to come to their colleges in a bid to keep their doors open.

In Europe abortion is not a major issue of contention. It is an accepted fact of life that many people avail of as a basic right for their convenience. The widespread use of abortion in Europe is one of the key factors in the continent's population decline, which is itself one of the major influences that contributed to Europe's economic meltdown – a meltdown that threatens the global economy at this moment.

Abortion is not a side issue in our world. It is a critical, albeit ignored element of the civilization that we live in, rather like cancer cells that sap life and hasten death. In future generations people will look on us and wonder how we could have been so sophisticated in science and lifestyles, and yet so barbaric in allowing the death of millions of fellow human beings.

Today as we remember the 39th anniversary of the legalizing of abortion in our country, each one of us needs to ask what we can do to promote a culture of life so that our civilization welcomes every life, respects and protects every life, because every human life is a precious gift of God. This means prayer and conversion – in our hearts, and then in our private and public actions. Everything we do and say has to contribute to that respect of life – it can never be a side issue in our considerations.
