“Speak Lord, for your servant is listening.” 1 Samuel 3:9

These words of instruction spoken to Samuel by Eli the priest are in fact addressed to each one of us. Too often our prayer is more like, “Speak Lord, for your servant is speaking.” Remember, it is not until Job puts his hand over his mouth and shuts up that God responds to him. Quieting ourselves and simply resting in the Lord is the hardest discipline in learning how to pray. We have a million things to think and worry about; things to plan and distract us from listening to God. This is why early morning and late evening can be the best times to pray. Simply resting and repeating simple prayers like “Jesus, I trust in You” or “Jesus, I offer you this day” or “Speak Lord, your servant is listening” and then quietly rest in Jesus.

Don’t expect a thunderbolt, at least in my experience that is rare. A quiet peace, a whisper as Elijah experiences God’s presence is far more likely. This might be why some of my best prayer occurs in the early morning or late evening when I am tired and simply calling out to Jesus.

St Therese of the Little Flower was often frustrated with the fact that she dozed off during her prayer until God gave her a vision of a baby falling asleep in the arms of her father. She thought that there is nothing more pleasing to a father than when his child falls asleep in his arms. Begin to learn how to pray by repeating some simple prayers, resting –maybe even dozing a bit and allow God to speak to your heart at these times.

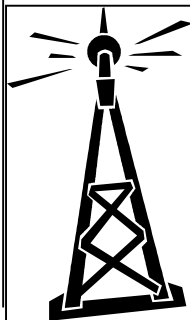

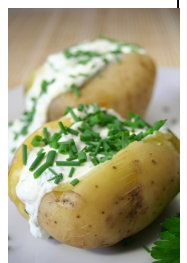
